

GENERAL CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS FOR TFL LAMINATES

To ensure best long-term performance from OFGO STUDIO's thermally fused laminates, please follow the cleaning recommendations provided in this document. We recommend cleaning the laminate surfaces immediately after soiling by wiping with a damp micro-fiber cloth or with the following recommended cleaning products. **It is important to ensure that no water is left sitting on the laminate for an elongated period of time. When cleaning always wipe dry.**

For day-to-day cleaning, wipe laminate with a damp cloth or sponge. A mild soap may be used. Wipe the laminate completely dry with a soft rag in a one-directional straight-line motion. If dust build up occurs, an occasional dusting can be done to help keep surfaces clean.

Basic stain removal:

To remove stains caused by common liquids and household products such as coffee, tea, mustard, ketchup, fatty substances, vinegar, wine, pencil, waxes and dirt we recommend using water, mild soap, micro-fiber cloth, or a melamine foam sponge.

Recommended cleaning agents:

- Mild liquid soap
- Clean water
- Micro-fiber cloth
- Soft cloth for drying

Cleaning agents to avoid:

- All abrasive cleaning materials such as steel wool, scrubbing pads, sponges with abrasive surfaces
 - Cream cleaners with abrasives and scouring powders
 - Strong concentrated acids or alkalis
 - Paper towels
- Using any of these items can cause irreversible damage to your laminate surfaces and alter its properties.

Hard to remove stains:

In cases where stains have dried, place a wet soft micro-fiber cloth with mild liquid soap on the incrustated area and allow 1 to 2 minutes to let soak. Remove the dissolved residue by wiping with the wet soft cloth. If the residue cannot be completely removed with the above method, use a wet melamine foam sponge with mild liquid soap. Once residue has been removed, wipe away excess cleaning detergent with clean water and a soft cloth.

Laminate Care Tips:

- Keep your furniture out of direct sunlight. Prolonged exposure may cause the color to fade over time.
- Hot pans or heat producing appliances, when set directly on the laminate, can mar the product's surface. Always use a heat shield, hot pad, or trivet.
- Sharp knives can damage the surface of the laminate lowering the wear and stain resistance of the surface. Always use a cutting board if cutting directly on the surface.
