

## OFGO STUDIO – Divert Program

OFGO STUDIO's Divert Program aims to achieve zero waste by providing customers with a service to help sell, donate, or recycle furniture assets at the end of their useful life.

### 1. Core Circularity Pathways

OFGO STUDIO provides three distinct recovery streams to ensure maximum environmental and social benefit:

- **Reuse (Furniture Take-Back for Refurbishment/Resale):** We assist clients with specifications for selling platforms or partner with liquidation and broker networks to keep functional furniture in use.
- **Donation (Social Return):** We match assets with registered charities and non-profits. To minimize transport emissions, we prioritize recipients within 50-200km of the decommissioning site where possible.
- **Recycling (End-of-Life Recovery):** Items that cannot be resold or donated can be disassembled in accordance with industry best-practice standards. OFGO STUDIO can assist in vetting all disposal facilities to ensure precise material separation and recovery of metals and other high-value components.

### 2. Tracking and Transparency

OFGO STUDIO maintains a formalized product take-back record that captures annual circularity metrics. Every material sent for recycling is tracked through the following data points to ensure ethical procedures:

- **Project Date:** The specific date of the diversion or decommissioning event.
- **Material Classification:** Identification of product types, such as task chairs or steel frames.
- **Diversion Metrics:** Recording the total weight or quantity of materials diverted from landfills (where available).
- **Final Destination:** Detailed records of the end-point, including specific facility names for recycling, donation recipients, or refurbishment centers.
